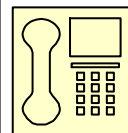

St Andrew's Amblers Half Day Walk: The Cloud near Congleton 11th September 2010

For our next walk we are going to walk to the summit of the Cloud. We will leave from St Andrews promptly at 9 am and we will start the walk from Timbersbrook on the Congleton side of the Cloud. We will ascend to the summit where we will have our coffee stop with fantastic views over the Cheshire plain. We then descend to Rushton by way of the Gritstone Trail and Staffordshire Way. We can stop for lunch at the Knott Inn in Rushton or return home if preferred.

Come prepared with a snack and for sun, rain and mud.

The walk is a linear walk, so we'll have to arrange the logistics of leaving a car at Rushton so that drivers can be transported back to Timbersbrook to collect their vehicles.

The pub at Rushton, "The Knott Inn", is not a walkers pub, so if we want to go inside we will have to remove boots and waterproofs. So it would be a good idea to bring a large plastic bag for boots and you may want to bring slippers or similar footwear.

We do not take up a collection during the service, but there is a wooden box by the doors as you come in to church for tithes and offerings. If you wish to give by standing order and/or Gift Aid, please see our Treasurer Graham Stanley.
